Re: COVID-19 Update, Campus re-opening.

Arizona Culinary Institute has reopened the campus to students and interns whose education was paused on March 27, 2020. Students can elect to attend on a voluntary basis only, until full resumption of classes begin on May 26, 2020.

Arizona Culinary Institute will follow recommendations from the CDC and The Arizona Department of Health Services for Essential businesses. Arizona Culinary will practice the following rules

- Limit public access to appointment only
- Taking temperature of all individuals entering the student areas.
- Mandatory wearing of face masks
- Mandatory wearing of gloves always and changing with each new task.
- Limit class sizes to promote social distancing
- Rigorous sanitizing of all student areas
- Requiring anyone who has been exposed or think they have the virus be kept away from the campus for a period of 14 days. And must have a medical release before returning to campus.
- Closing of duJour Restaurant to public dining until June 1, 2020

Arizona Culinary Institute has also pushed the future start for new culinary students out until May 26, 2020.
